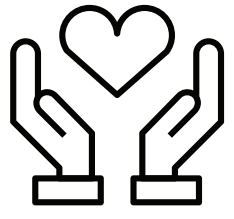

## PRIMARY CARE

For a health checkup, preventive screening or non-urgent health issue, such as:



ACHES AND PAINS  
COUGH OR COLD  
FEVER  
UNEXPLAINED  
BODY CHANGES

## IMMEDIATE CARE

For a worsening medical condition, such as:



FEVER  
SORE THROAT  
SINUS OR EAR PAIN  
ASTHMA  
HEADACHE  
URINARY INFECTIONS  
VOMITING  
DIARRHEA  
ORTHOPEDIC INJURIES AND MINOR DISLOCATIONS  
FLU  
MINOR INJURIES SUCH AS BRUISES, NOSE BLEEDS, MINOR BURNS AND CUTS  
SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASES

## EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

For a life-threatening medical condition, such as:



CHEST PAIN OR PRESSURE  
SEIZURES OR CONVULSIONS  
DIFFICULTY BREATHING  
SERIOUS INJURY  
SEVERE BURNS  
HEAVY BLEEDING  
SIGNS OF A STROKE  
CHOKING  
POISONING  
LOSS OF CONSCIOUSNESS  
FEVERS IN CHILDREN UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE  
SEVERE SHORTNESS OF BREATH  
SHOULDER DISLOCATIONS  
SEVERE DIZZINESS  
SEVERE AND UNUSUAL HEADACHES
